Winter 2009 Session (Jan. 5 – May 15, 2009)

Important Note: Fees below do not include the Alberta and Canadian Fencing Association memberships, which can vary from \$15 (Recreation) to \$50 (Competitive). AFA/CFF membership is valid from September 2008 to August 2009. Note: To compete in provincial or national fencing competitions you must have a competitive membership.

Family Discount – \$150 discount for each additional immediate family member per session taking twice weekly classes. Regular AFA fees still apply. (This discount does not apply to once-per-week classes.)

Fees stated below are for one session only.

BEGINNER – For recreational fencers with fewer than 2 years experience. 1-hour classes are designed with the very young fencer in mind. 1.5-hour classes are available for fencers who can accommodate longer periods of instruction and exercise. Purchase of a glove is highly recommended for all classes (\$20).

SATURDAY FENCERS: The 10-week classes do not always run consecutively due to the competition schedule. If a fencer cannot attend his/her regular class for legitimate reasons, he or she can make up the class during a scheduled weekday class at the club.

All Winter fees must be paid by Jan. 31, 2009 or a \$50 late fee will be applied. Cash and cheques only accepted.

Fencers must comply with our Coaching Policy as posted at the club.

VOLUNTEER CHEQUES: Competitive fencers must supply a \$250 volunteer cheque. This will be returned to you upon completing one 4-hour volunteer shift at a club event or 4 hours of other work for the club ***in each session***. A registration is incomplete until the volunteer cheque is received by the EFC.
